Please send your topic proposals with a short (200-400 word) synopsis to orkun.akseli@manchester.ac.uk by 15 May 2024 for consideration. Notification of accepted proposals will be made by 31 May 2024.

We have been offered the possibility to publish some of the papers in the *Uniform Law Review* and the *Law and Financial Markets Review*. Manchester is a beautiful city in the autumn. The Manchester airport is served by many airlines from around the world. From the airport, Manchester city centre and the University of Manchester are reachable by train, metro, bus and taxi after a short drive.
